MOSA has supported my efforts through my secondary ordinary level education. Though I did well on my national form IV exam and graduated with division III, I was unable to move forward to Advanced Level. However, MOSA did not drop me but supported me to go college for a Medical Assistant Diploma which I started in 2015 at City Institute of Health in Dar-Es-Salaam.

In 2016 after one year at the Institute of Health, it occurred that most of the students were not doing well including myself; out of 169 who set for the finals, only nine of us passed. MOSA realized the problem and decided to move me to Muyoge Health Institute located in Iringa Region in the Southern

Highlands of Tanzania. I will be finishing my first term in September, and so far I have maintained a 4.0 GPA. I am confident that I will be able to finish and I am scheduled to graduate in February of 2018.

The lack of text books, laptops for research, learning materials and printing equipment make the learning process very challenging.
